All you need to know

Sponsorship

The pandemic has hit our fundraising really hard and whilst this is a fun family event a core aim of this walk is to bring the community together and raise money for White Lodge.

There is no set fundraising target we would be grateful for as much sponsorship as possible. Any size donation will help White Lodge change a life. For example:

£25 of sponsorship would provide a child aged 4-12 with 1-2-1 support from a playworker for 3 hours

£50 of sponsorship would fund a meeting for a parent coming to terms with their child's disability with one of our volunteer parent befrienders

£100 of sponsorship would provide a pre-school child with cerebral palsy with a hydrotherapy session for 5 x 30 minute sessions

Parking and Charges

There is a large car park at Virginia Water Lake including allocated parking bays for visitors with a disability. Please note the following charges apply: Up to 1 hr - £3.00. 1 to 2 hrs £6.00. 2 to 3 hrs £9.00. 3 or more hrs £12.00.

Where to go upon arrival

Please head towards the main entrance of the lake where you will spot the White Lodge red gazebo and start line.

Disabled access

Although the site around the lake is fully accessible, please note there are some slightly uneven surfaces and moderate inclines.

Toilets

There are public toilets, including disabled access toilets at the lake.

The route

The 6.5K route is a lap of the lake and the 1K is to the totem pole. Marshalls will be on route and leading the way.

Your pooches!

Dogs are the responsibility of owners and need to be kept under control at all times. All dogs need to be kept on the lead at the start and finish. Owners to clear up and use appropriate dog bins.

Dress up and dress appropriately

Get your pooch '*Santa Paws'd Up!*' - Be creative and remember that there are prizes for the best dog and owner combo!

But remember, the great british weather is unpredictable so please check the forecast before and come prepared.
